Spread of Covid-19 Coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Self</li> <li>• Customers</li> <li>• Anyone else who physically comes in contact with myself in relation to my business</li> </ul>	<p><b>ENQUIRE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ask the homeowner to confirm that they and all of their family have been free of any Covid 19 symptoms within the past 14 days before entering the customers' property.</li> </ul> <p><b>HAND WASHING</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hands washed with antibacterial soap when entering and leaving customers premises.</li> <li>• Drying of hands with disposable paper towels.</li> <li>• Gel hand sanitisers in frequent use to compliment the hand washing routine.</li> </ul>	<p>To help reduce the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19) remind customers of the public health advice. (Social distancing, cleaning and PPE etc.).</p> <p>Hands to be washed on a regular basis for 20 seconds with water and antibacterial soap and dried with disposable towels. Catch coughs and sneezes in tissues – Follow Catch it, Bin it, Kill it and to avoid touching face, eyes, nose or mouth with unclean hands. Tissues will be made available throughout the workplace.</p>	Self	Daily	Yes / No

Spread of Covid-19 Coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Self</li> <li>• Customers</li> <li>• Anyone else who physically comes in contact with myself in relation to my business</li> </ul>	<p><b>CLEANING</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Frequently cleaning and disinfecting objects, tools and surfaces that are touched regularly particularly in areas of high use such as door handles, light switches etc. using appropriate antibacterial spray products and methods.</li> <li>• Vehicle door handles, keys, steering wheel, hand break and gear stick etc. will be regularly sprayed and wiped down with antibacterial spray.</li> </ul> <p><b>PPE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wear disposable face mask where appropriate.</li> </ul> <p><b>SOCIAL DISTANCING</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reducing the number of persons in any single room to comply with the 2-metre gap recommended by the Public Health England.</li> <li>• Consideration given to processes to ensure social distancing is in place as may be necessary.</li> <li>• Hi Viz vest worn printed with the two metre 'Social Distancing' message to reinforce compliance.</li> </ul>	<p>Hands should be sanitized on a regular basis, as the wearing of disposable gloves may not always be possible since thin gloves are easily damaged by tools and cables etc.</p> <p>Remember that the wearing of gloves is not a substitute for good hand washing.</p>	Self	Daily	Yes / No

Spread of Covid-19 Coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Self</li> <li>• Customers</li> <li>• Suppliers</li> <li>• Anyone else who physically comes in contact with myself in relation to my business</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>FOOD AND DRINK</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Only food and drink that has been brought with me will be consumed whilst on customers premises and these should only be consumed inside the vehicle to avoid any possible contamination.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If any customer becomes unwell with a new continuous cough, a high temperature or a loss of taste and or smell during the course of any work, then any work in progress will be made safe and will then cease for a minimum of 14 days.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>SUPPLIERS</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Follow all guidance and instructions given by suppliers whilst ordering, collecting and purchasing any stock items and materials that may be necessary to complete work.</li> </ul>	<p>Politely decline any tea, coffee, drinks or biscuits etc. offered by customers.</p> <p>Avoid, where possible, purchasing materials and supplies directly from store premises, but try to order for contact free collection or delivery.</p>	Self	Daily	Yes / No
